We are currently seeking Expressions of Interest for LGI's 2023 Moving Forward residency program.

Applications are now open and close 9am Monday 31 October 2022.

Who can apply?

- Choreographers, trained and professional dancers, recent graduates, and dance artists with a track record of creating work.
- LGI encourages applications from artists identifying as First Nations, CALD, Deaf or Disabled, and LGBTQI+.
- Applications can be made by individuals, collectives, or companies.

About the Moving Forward residency program

- One to three-week residencies designed to support artists to progress a project towards production.
- Suitable for projects that are ready to refine and are approaching an outcome.
- Moving Forward residencies include a Critter session (an invited or public sharing), and residents provide a dedicated blog post for the LGI website.
- Residents receive a stipend of \$1,000 per week.
- These residencies can be fulltime only (Monday-Friday, 12-6pm).

Moving Forward residents also have dedicated access to:

- Purpose-built studio space at WXYZ Studios, home of LGI.
- Access to LGI Morning Class for free for the duration of your residency for you and your collaborators.
- Use of studio equipment, which can include a sound system, studio lighting, projector, and iPad for video
- Support and guidance from the LGI team and access to a hot desk.

Other FAQs

- All residencies in this application round must be completed during 2023. Dates will be organised with successful applicants at the earliest opportunity.
- Residencies will take place at WXYZ Studios, 130 Dryburgh Street, North Melbourne, unless the company and artist agree otherwise in advance.
