Lucy Guerin Inc (LGI) is inviting applications for studio residencies to take place at WXYZ Studios during 2020.

This information pack is designed to offer the information required to apply for 2020's residency program, including the two types of residency available, who's eligible and how to apply.

**Welcome to your place
to explore, create and redefine**

There are two types of LGI Residency you can apply for:

‘Make a Start’ Residencies

Make a Start are **one to two-week** residencies designed for **early-stage developments** and **creative experiments**.

These residencies are for projects in the **early stages** that are challenging choreographic thinking and **exploring new experimental approaches** to dance practice.

You can choose to request these residencies to be **full-time** (Monday to Friday, 12–6pm daily) or **Out-of-Time** (evenings and weekends).

Make a Start residencies need **no public outcome**, and other support such as the dedicated blog post is offered as optional, rather than a requirement.

Artists will be supported by the whole LGI team (availability dependent) through studio feedback and **Coffee with LGI**.

There will be a **second round of applications** open in mid-2020 for *Make a Start* Residencies from September to December 2020.

‘Moving Forward’ Residencies

Moving Forward are (**up to**) **three-week** residencies designed to support artists to **progress a project towards an outcome**, such as a presentation.

These residencies are for projects that are ready to **refine and consolidate** existing ideas into a public presentation.

These residencies can be **full-time** (Monday to Friday, 12–6pm daily) only.

Moving Forward residencies are requested to have a **Critter session** – an invited or public sharing – and a **dedicated blog post** on the LGI website.

Artists will be artistically supported by Lucy Guerin or LGI’s Resident Director (availability dependent), as well as the whole LGI team, including **Coffee with LGI**.

This is the **only round of applications** for 2020’s *Moving Forward* program.

At this time, there is **no funding** available for either of these residency types, though all the in-kind support listed is offered to all Residents.

*An additional round for Make a Start residencies will open in mid-2020 for September onwards.

All residents have dedicated access to...

- **Dedicated, high-quality studio space** at WXYZ Studios,
- **Studio equipment** including sound and AV kit (dependent on availability),
- **Daily training** via LGI Morning Class,
- **Coffee with LGI:** an opportunity to tell us more about your project so we can help you create connections to other artists and organisations,
- **Administrative assistance** and access to LGI's Hot Desk, and
- **Artistic support** from the LGI team, which may include Lucy Guerin and our 2020 Resident Director (dependent on availability).

The LGI team will endeavour to tailor support to your project, before, during and after your LGI Residency period.

Who can apply?

Choreographers, professional dancers, recent graduates and dance artists with a track record of creating work.

Applications can be made by **individuals, collectives or companies**, though one person must be nominated as the point of contact for the application.

We actively encourage applications from First Nations artists as well as those artists who identify as deaf or disabled.

What else you need to know...

- All residencies in this application round **must be completed during 2020**. Dates will be organised with successful applicants at the earliest opportunity. While LGI will do its utmost to be flexible with scheduling, it is the responsibility of the artist to utilise their time allowance within the calendar year.
- All artists-in-residence agree to have elements of their residency **documented by LGI**. This will be used for archival and research purposes, and, with prior agreement, use in publicity materials. Documentation may include photos, video footage and sound recordings.
- Residencies will **take place at WXYZ Studios**, 130 Dryburgh Street, North Melbourne, unless LGI and the artist agree otherwise in advance.
- All residency **support is offered in-kind**. Specific in-kind values can be supplied, by request. The nature of support offered by the LGI team is dependent on availability as well as the activities of the company and studios.
- LGI's support must be acknowledged in all **future marketing** and programming material, should this project go forward. Logos and preferred phrasing of acknowledgements will be provided to all successful applicants.
- LGI is committed to making our programs and events **accessible**. If you have accessibility requirements, please contact Tom, Studio Producer, at tom@lucyguerininc.com to discuss how we can best support your application and residency.
