Landing on their feet

WANTED: young people with zero dance experience to appear in a theatre show about dancing.

Star choreographer Lucy Guerin put the call out early this year for Dandenong's Drum Theatre, and two local lads who were between jobs got the gig. Michael Hussey-Smith, 33, and Billy-Joe Wikitera, 21, are on a seven-stop tour with Untrained and valiantly matching the moves of two professional dancers.

Untrained was conceived by Guerin as a way of exploring "how non-dancers deal with choreographed dance".

"For the non-dancers, it's been a leap into the unknown requiring courage and a sense of humour," she says.
